Associate Membership

is open to any individual or company with interest related to the Vermont specialty food industry that is not a producer or manufacturer. Associate members will be subject to approval by the Board of Directors. Associate members have no voting privileges.

Membership Dues

are based on annual gross sales. VSFA membership dues also include associate membership in the Vermont Retail & Grocers Association (VRGA), a state wide trade association of 700 stores and over 200 suppliers in the industry. Dues are billed in January of every year.
