## Important reminders:

- Table space is provided with a tablecloth.
- Tablespace is approximately 4 ft x 4 ft and will be marked with your logo, City and County when you arrive. These will be placed in specific areas to provide the best mix of food and beverage companies. Some of the larger tables will need to be shared among companies.
- **Parking:** Vendors can unload at the Capitol Plaza in the front, back and side street. Shuttle service will be available until 5:15 to and from the Department of Labor (we are working on extending this time). Parking is also available on the street (must pay until 5:00) or behind the Capitol Plaza Hotel (permit parking with ticket purchase). **Plan to arrive with plenty of time to park and unpack.**
- Be mindful of your neighbors and their space. If you would like to rearrange your space in a way that might interfere with someone else's display notify them immediately.
- **Signage**: Tabletop signs are allowed but you cannot attach anything to the walls, windows or use any sign that would block another company from view.
- Ice is free and accessible from the kitchen.
- If you need to prepare what you are bringing, the kitchen will help you with advance two-week notice (check box above).
- **Dishes, Utensils, Cups & Napkins:** You will need to come self-contained for the tasting. This means bringing your own plates, cups, napkins, toothpicks, etc. Trash and recycling will be provided.
- This is a **tasting only event**, but marketing materials are encouraged for attending retailers, distributors and legislators.
